Instruction Sheet

Please read these brief instructions before you fill out the scholarship application. Doing so will increase your knowledge of the scholarship process and perhaps increase your chances of receiving a scholarship.

These scholarships are for current USU students attending FULL-TIME (12 credits or more).

The Huntsman School of Business offers a number of scholarships, each of which has different criteria. A list of the scholarships in the school and their criteria are available at www.usu.edu/ats/generalcatalog/scholarships. Scholarships are merit-based (gpa) or need-based (financial). This application is for consideration of all scholarships offered by the school. Individual departments may also offer additional scholarships. Students who have University scholarships may not be eligible for a Huntsman School of Business scholarship.

If you would like to be considered for a need-based scholarship, you must fill out and submit a FAFSA form. You can do this online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Please attach a copy of the completed form, including the Estimated Family Contribution page, to your scholarship application. If you need assistance completing this form, contact the Financial Aid Office.

Students with primary majors in the Huntsman School of Business will be given first priority in the scholarship awarding process.

What happens to your Application?

Your application is considered for a cash award by the Huntsman School of Business Scholarship Committee. After the awarding has been completed, award and decline letters are printed and mailed by the Programs and Advising Center, BUS 309.

How to complete the Application

Please print legibly in dark ink or type. Make sure your address is legible - this is where all correspondence is sent. Complete all blanks. If it does not apply to you write NA (Not Applicable). Please check the major listed on your grade transcript and make sure it is correct. If it is not, please contact the Records Office. You will not be awarded a scholarship by the Huntsman School of Business unless you are officially admitted to the college.

Dates to remember

March 2, 2009 - Scholarship applications due for the Huntsman School of Business. Applications must be turned into BUS 309 *no later than 5:00 p.m.* on this date.

April 15, 2009 - Receive by mail an award or decline letter from the Huntsman School of Business. The Programs and Advising Center will send letters concerning cash awards.

April 30, 2009 - Return signed acceptance letter for cash awards to the Programs and Advising Center. *Remember, a copy of the donor thank you letter must be included with your acceptance.* Make sure you keep a copy of the award letter for your own records.

Fall Awards Banquet – If you are awarded and accept a scholarship, you must attend the Fall Awards Banquet or forfeit your scholarship.
